Brief Details of Dispute / Litigation	TSR Films Pvt Ltd (TSR) and UFO Moviez India Ltd (UFO / the Company) had executed Advertisement Agreement dated 23 rd December 2023 (Agreement) vide which UFO was granted exclusive on-screen, in-cinema advertisement rights on TSR's advertisement screens. Dispute pertains to interpretation of certain contractual terms of the Agreement by the Parties pursuant to which TSR has filed application with the High Court of Judicature at Madras, seeking interim injunction against UFO under section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
